

VESA Mount Standards

What is VESA?

VESA (Video Electronics Standards Association) is a professional organisation made up of a group of video electronics industry professionals. Their purpose is to review proposals and develop standards to promote uniformity in the video electronics industry. Established in 1989, VESA works to develop industry-wide interface standards for a large variety of products including Flat Panel TVs and monitors.



What are VESA Mount Standards?

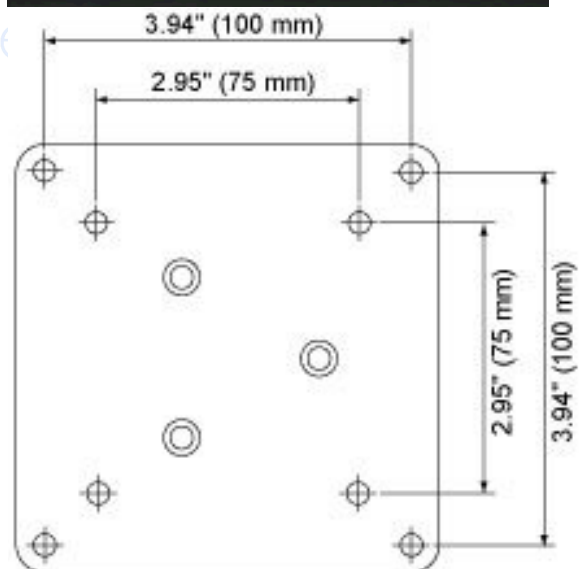
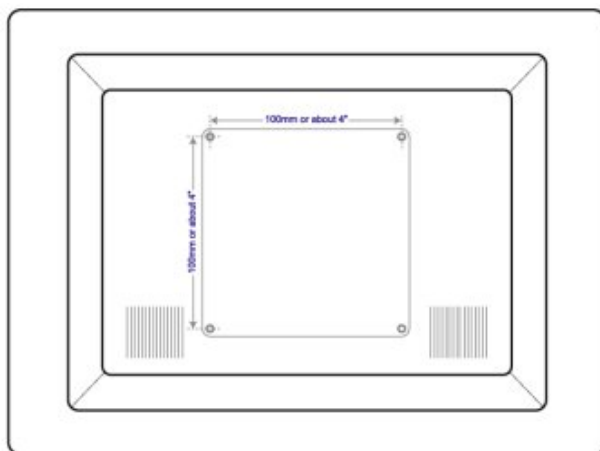
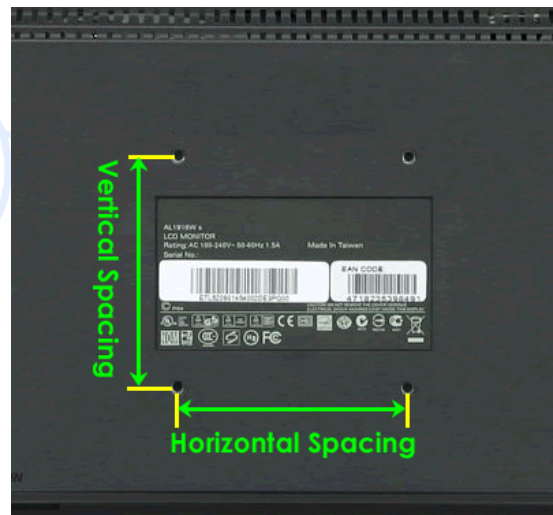
VESA has developed a set of standards for the manufacturing of flat screen televisions and PC monitors. Aquavision complies with this standard by adhering to an industry wide “hole pattern” on the back of their displays for mounting purposes. A typical VESA hole pattern for flat panel displays can be one of the following sizes:

- 75 mm x 75 mm (75 mm = 2.95 inches)
- 100 mm x 100 mm (100mm = 3.94 inches)
- 200 mm x 200 mm (200 mm = 7.87 inches)
- 400 mm x 400 mm (400 mm = 15.7 inches)

All the above sizes use M4 x 10mm fixings.
For larger screens the sizes are as follows:

- 200 mm x 200 mm (200 mm = 7.87 inches)
- 400 mm x 400 mm (400 mm = 15.7 inches)
- 600 mm x 200 mm (600 mm = 23.57 inches)
- 600 mm x 400 mm
- 800 mm x 400 mm (800 mm = 31.4 inches)

These sizes use M6 x 10mm or M8 x 15mm fixings.
All Aquavision surface mount screens are VESA compliant.
