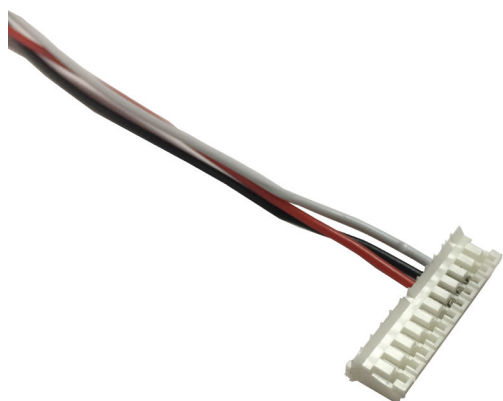


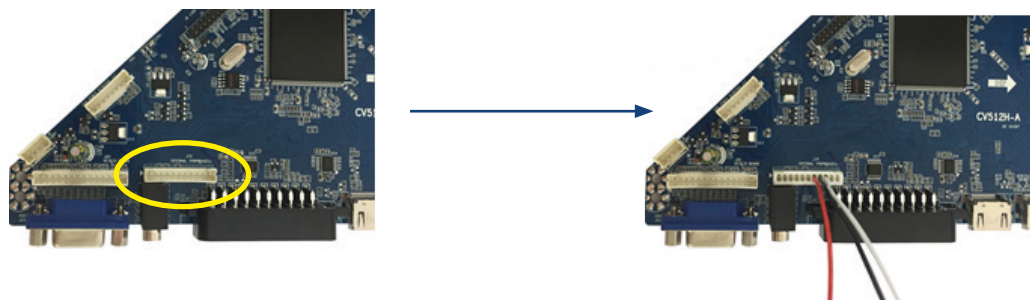
Audio In Adaptor

All current Genesis & Nexus products have the facility to have an Auxiliary Audio input added to them. This is perfect should you wish to add a Bluetooth, Sonos or similar “audio only” source. You will need to purchase an AVF-AUDIN cable from your supplying dealer.

NOTE: This feature is only available via an internal connection so should be installed by competent engineers only.






You will need to open the back of your Aquavision LCD by removing the 8 fixing screws that attach the component box to the LCD screen. Inside you will see a PCB mounted socket marked as “INTERNAL YPBPR AUDIO” (circled in yellow on the image below), insert the Audio In lead into this socket:



You will need to connect the cables to your audio source as follows. This input is designed to accept line level 0db signals.

NOTE: To eliminate any initial “thump” the input is designed to need the “mute” to be turned ON then OFF to eliminate any potential damage to speakers.
